






Following School and Daycare Closures, 60% of Parents Have Not Found Alternative Care

"How have your childcare or school arrangements when working changed?"




Parents Have Nearly Doubled the Time Spent on Education and Household Tasks





Remote Learning Is Meant to Continue Children's Routines, but It's Disrupting Parents' Schedules




Many Men Are Stepping Up to Help, but Women Still Have Greater Responsibilities for Children and Home

"In your household under coronavirus crisis conditions, how are you and your partner splitting responsibilities?"





Women Are Shouldering a Greater Share of the Additional Time Spent on Childcare and Household Tasks




Many Parents Feel Their Ability to Perform at Work Has Dropped, Particularly Those with Young Children

"My ability to perform at work has decreased because of higher family and home responsibilities under coronavirus"




I am worried about my performance review at work (%)




I am sleeping fewer hours (%)



I am worried about my mental well-being (%)




I am worried about my children's education (%)
